Effective April 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, we will be changing our reference interval for 25-OH Vitamin D in order to be in alignment with Canadian recommendations. There is no change to the method or specimen requirements.

New reference interval will be:

<b>nmol/L</b>	<b>Interpretation</b>
<25	Vitamin D deficiency
25-75	Sub-optimal Vitamin D status
>75	Desirable Vitamin D status
>250	Potential Adverse effects
